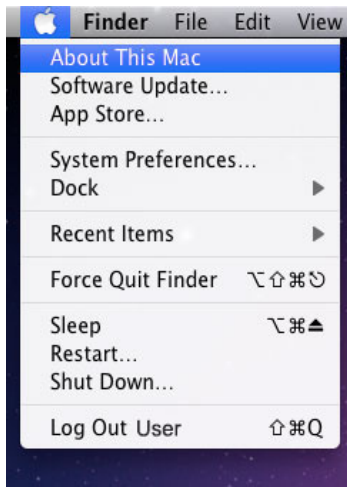


# How do I... Check my Device Operating System Version

## APPLE: Macbook Air, Macbook Pro, iMac

1. Click on the Apple menu and select About.



2. Take note of your Mac operating system version. In this example, it's Version 10.15 (19A583).

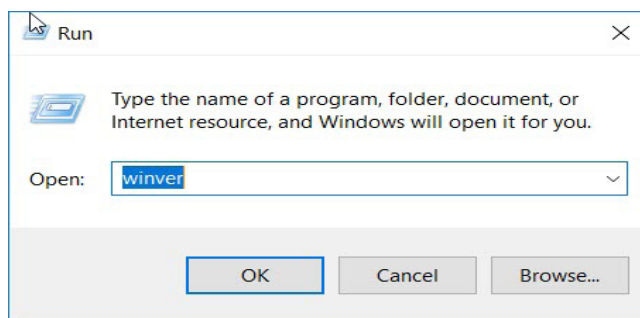
## WINDOWS: Microsoft, Dell, Lenovo

1. Press the Windows key on your keyboard, then press the R key.



The Run field pops up.

3. Type winver in the Run field, and click OK.



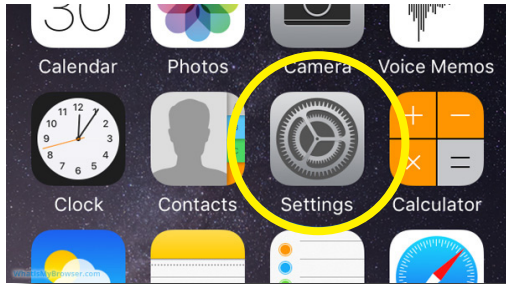
4. Take note of your Windows operating system version. In this example, it's Version 1803 (OS Build 17134.1069).



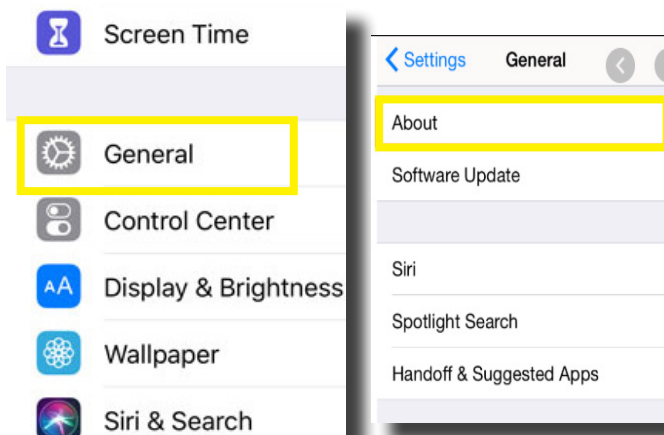
# How do I... Check my Device Operating System Version

**iPHONE & iPad:** iPhone 11, iPhone X, iPad

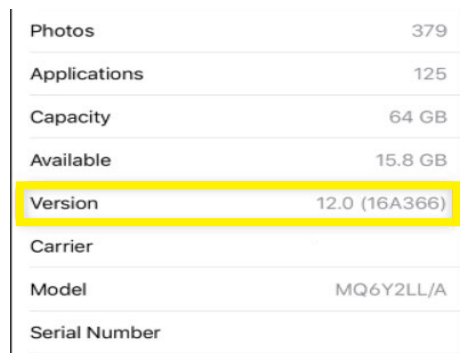
1. Click Settings.



2. Click General > About.

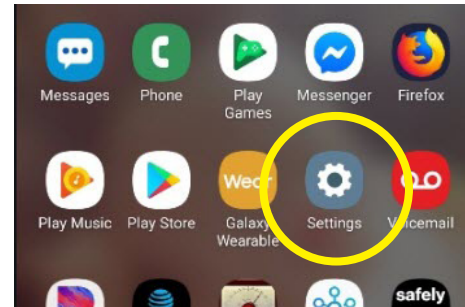


3. Take note of your iPhone/iPad operating system version. In this example, it's Version 12.0 (16A366).

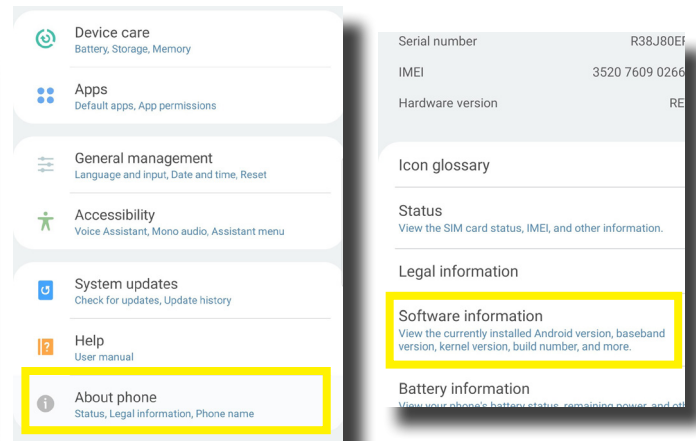


**ANDROID:** Google Pixel, LG ThinQ, Samsung Galaxy, Samsung Galaxy Tab

1. Click Settings.



2. Click About phone > Software information.



3. Take note of your Android device operating system version. In this example, it's Android Version 9.
