

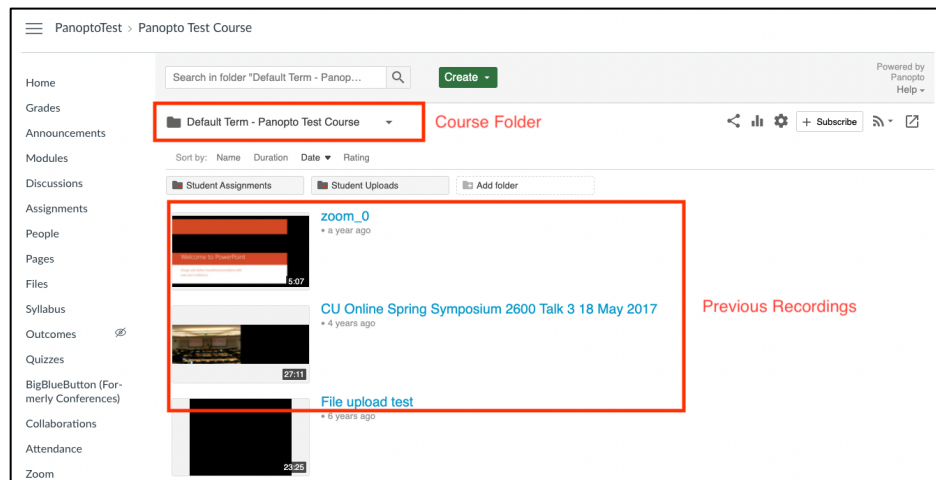
Getting Started with Panopto (for Instructors)



Panopto is a classroom lecture capture, screen capture, and video hosting solution for faculty at the Anschutz Medical Campus. Panopto is integrated into Canvas and is installed on all classroom computers at CU Anschutz. Using Panopto is easy, but does require some initial setup in Canvas before you can use it.

Activating Panopto in Canvas

1. Log into Canvas, ucdenver.instructure.com and click on your course.
2. Go to Settings > Navigation.
3. Find Panopto Recordings in the list, click on the three dots and choose “enable.”
4. Click “save” at the bottom of the screen.
5. Refresh your page, and click on Panopto Recordings in your course menu.
6. You will see the default course folder at the top as well as any recordings.



Creating New Recordings

1. To create a new recording from Canvas, click on Panopto Recordings in the course menu.
2. Choose the green “create” button and select either “Record in an Application” or “Record in Browser.”
3. Follow the onscreen instructions for starting, installing or recording using Panopto. Mac Users will have to authorize Panopto to use the camera, microphone, and screen capture functions.
4. When you stop the recordings, it will automatically be uploaded to the folder associated with that Canvas course.
