

# WEBSITES FOR YOU




**Endnote:** is a commercial reference management software package, used to manage bibliographies and references when writing essays and articles. It is produced by Clarivate Analytics.

**Techsmith:** Create and share images and videos for better training, tutorials, lessons, and everyday communication.



**Mathematica:** Helps with symbolic math, numerical calculations, graphics, programming, documenting and displaying work.

**MATLAB:** allows matrix manipulations, plotting of functions and data, implementation of algorithms, creation of user interfaces, and interfacing with programs written in other languages.
