



Canvas is the learning management system at the University of Colorado Denver. It contains several cool features that will make courses more engaging and easier to keep up with. To get started, follow the steps below.

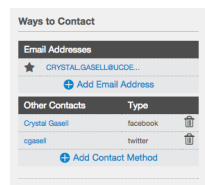
1. **Log in.** You can sign into Canvas at <https://ucdenver.instructure.com/> using your UCD Access credentials. If you forget, you can reset those at <http://myaccount.ucdenver.edu>.

2. **Find your courses.** Courses you are enrolled in show up as tiles on your dashboard. You can view past, present, and future courses by clicking “courses” and then “all courses” in the left-hand navigation.

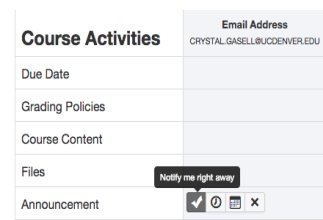
3. **Update your profile.** Your profile is visible to other users and includes a photo, pronoun option, a biography, and links. To update your profile, click “account” in the left-hand navigation and then “profile.” To edit your profile, click “edit” in the upper right-hand corner of your profile.

4. **Set your notifications.** Canvas can notify your email address, phone, or even your Twitter or Facebook account of happenings in your course! Customize the settings so that you know when a new discussion is posted, grades are available, or when countless other course events occur.

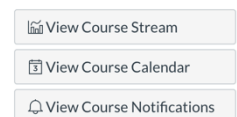
- **Add other accounts.** To add other accounts to Canvas, click “account” in the left-hand navigation and then “settings.” In the right-hand column of your settings, you can optionally link other email addresses or social media accounts.



- **Customize global notifications.** To customize your global notifications, click “account” in the left-hand navigation and then “notifications.” From this page, you can enable notifications for all kinds of different course events and their frequency - Right Away / Daily / Weekly / None.



- **Customize notifications by course.** If you want more control over your notifications, you can enable or disable notifications by course, or modify the frequency of notifications per course. To change your course level notifications, go to the course



homepage and click “view course notifications.” If you do not change these notifications, your courses will automatically inherit your global notification settings.

5. **Download the mobile app.** Canvas has created mobile apps for iOS and Android that allow you to access your schedule, discussions, announcements and more.



To download, search the Google Play Store or the Apple Store for the “Canvas Student” app.

6. **Learn about frequently used functionality.** Every course may use different tools within the Canvas platform. However, there are a few common things that you may be asked to do. Review these guides to make sure you are ready!

7. **Make sure your browser is up to date.** To have the best Canvas experience, you need the latest and greatest browser. We highly recommend updating to the newest version of whatever browser you are using as well as the most up-to-date Flash plug-in.
