## **GlobalProtect VPN Installation Guide for Macs**

- 1. There are two steps for using the university's new VPN:
  - a. Register and install Duo Security
  - b. Download and install GlobalProtect VPN for your Mac




Note: Mac users running High Sierra (10.13) and higher <u>may</u> need to complete the following three steps.


- 1. Open System Preferences by clicking on the Apple symbol in your top navigation on the left-hand side or System Preferences icon on your bottom task bar.
- 2. Click on Security and Privacy.



3. High Sierra may generate a message informing that PaloAlto installed software and asking whether you would like to allow. Click on the message to allow the software installation.




 Select the Download Mac32/64 bit GlobalProtect agent. By default, the installer is downloaded to your *Downloads* folder. Go to Finder and double-click GlobalProtect.pkg.




3. Select where you would like to install the software.




4. Check the GlobalProtect box.




5. Click install to begin the installation.



6. Enter your network credentials and click Install Software.



7. You may see an additional popup to enter in your keychain. Select "Always Allow".



8. Close the installer once you receive the installation was successful message.
