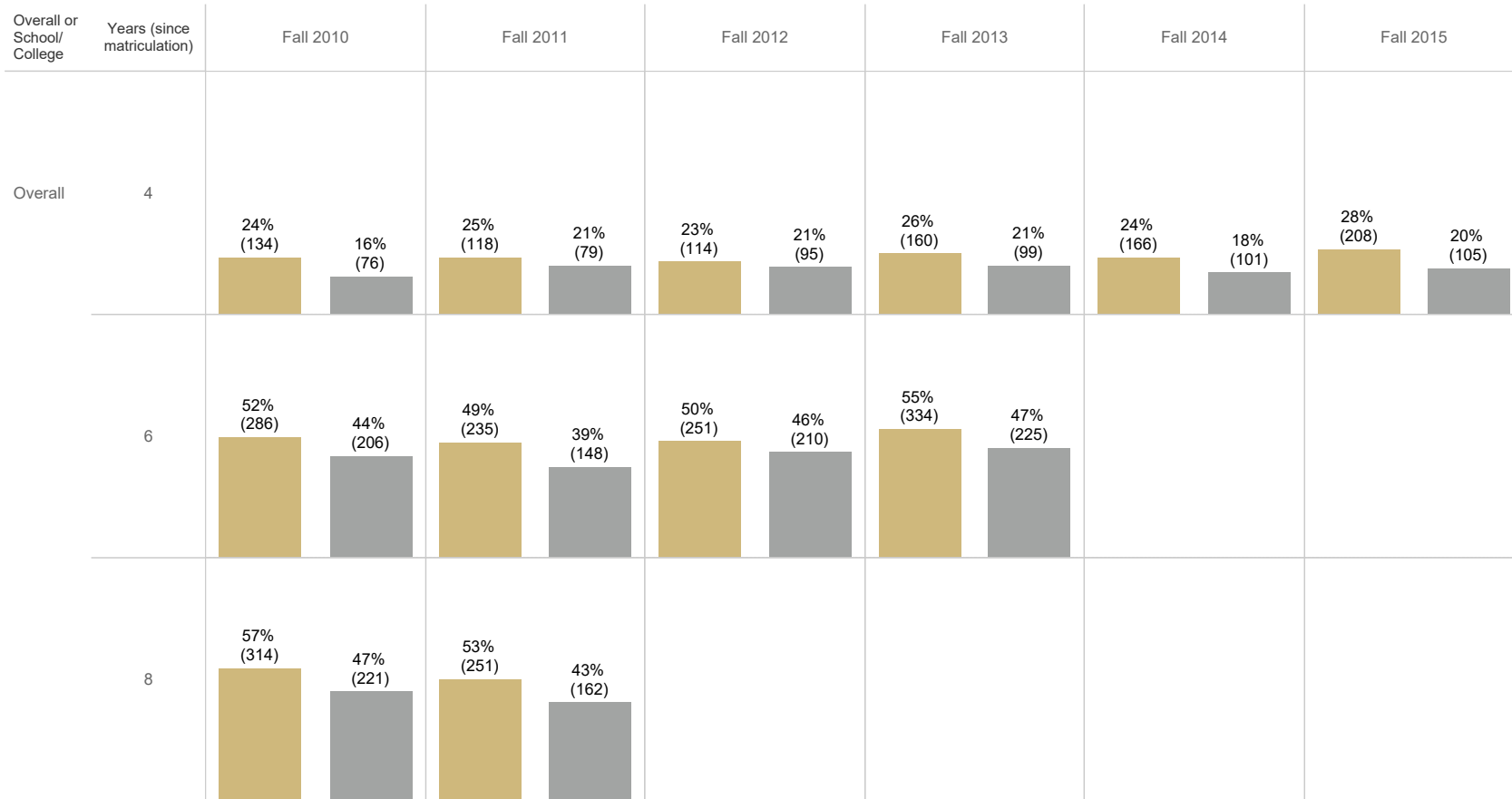


## Graduation Rate Trends by Years Since Matriculation
