
Hispanic-Latinx Heritage Month

Latinx Hispanic Heritage Month is a celebration held annually from September 15th to October 15th in the United States. This celebration honors the histories, cultures, and contributions of American citizens whose ancestors are from Spain, Mexico, the Caribbean, and Central and South America.

The observation started in 1968 as Hispanic Heritage Week under President Lyndon Johnson and was expanded to cover 30 days in 1988 under the Reagan admin.

September 15th is significant because it marks the anniversary of independence for several Latin American countries such as Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, and Nicaragua.


