Aside from a reminder on those dates are two important messages—and some things to consider.

- 2) Please let me reaffirm that career readiness, entrepreneurship, internships and externships are important elements for any student entering into the creative industries. - 3) Now is a good time to consider, and perhaps plan, for participation in Study Abroad. The College of Arts & Media has had many exceptional Study Abroad programs for 2-3 weeks duration. This coming year there are fine arts programs in Europe (Denmark and Florence), a recording arts program in Prague, and a music program in Cuba. A semester abroad possibility is in the conceptual or talking stage—and would likely involve more of a generalized approach to the creative industries—rather than the major-specific specialized and shorter study abroad programs that have been in place. If semester abroad programs are approved, they could be in the Fall of '21 or Spring of '22.
