# Reduction of Laboratory Operations

---

Due to the SARS-CoV-2 virus and resulting COVID19 infections, Exsera BioLabs will need to take some precautionary measures that will impact your contracts.

Effective 18Mar2020 the Anschutz Medical Campus of the University of Colorado Medical School is enforcing limitations on the employees allowed on campus to enforce social distancing. This includes the locking of all buildings and limiting access at all times to those badged individuals deemed critical.

While such measures can dramatically reduce the spread of the virus and in turn reduce the eventual load on our health care systems, this will also limit our ability to receive and process specimens.

Therefore, we request that you:

1. Suspend or hold any shipments that can be delayed until at least mid-April.
2. If this is impossible, please schedule all deliveries to arrive on Wednesday and alter Exsera staff immediately.
3. Be patient with the timelines for delivery of results.
4. Communicate with Exsera any concerns and questions.

We hold the health and safety of our staff as our paramount goal and with that in mind; we will work to do our best to also fulfill our commitments to deliverables. We will keep you informed of developments in our approach to the current viral pandemic. We, of course, regret the inconveniences.
