Reduction of Laboratory Operations

The Anschutz Medical Campus of the University of Colorado Medical School is still enforcing limitations on the employees allowed on campus to enforce social distancing. Well the State of Colorado is lifting some restrictions; the City of Aurora is maintaining “Stay at Home” restrictions through at least 08May2020. These limitations mean that Exsera is working at approximately 40% of normal staffing in the lab. Therefore, standard turnaround times are extended.

COVID-19 Impacts to Exsera Operations:

1. We are now open for the receipt of specimens.
2. Please be mindful that flights maybe problematic so we advise schedule shipments early in the week so delays do not push receipt into the weekend. The campus is not staffed to receive shipments on the weekends.
